

## Singing His Praise

### Ps. 105: 1-6

The Psalmist gives us some good instruction on how to praise God in Ps. 105 and today we are going to look at the first section of that Ps.

#### 1. Praise the Lord!

In the Hebrew verse one just says, "Praise the Lord!" yadhah = to praise or confess! This is really declaring Who God is to whomever we see!

We are to Praise the Lord always without out stopping – wherever we are or whatever we are doing – we don't stop praising God!

- a. We call on His name (s)! Scripture helps us know God by what He is called in scripture!
  - i. The God who Heals - Jehovah Rapha
  - ii. The God of my peace – Jehovah Shalom
  - iii. The God of Righteousness – Jehovah Tsidkenu
  - iv. God Almighty = El Shaddai
  - v. The Lord Most High = El Elyon
  - vi. Lord = Adoni
  - vii. The God my Shepherd = Jehovah Raah
  - viii. The Lord is Here = Jehovah Shammah
  - ix. The God who sees = Jehovah Jireh
  - x. The Lord of Armies = Jehovah Sabaoth

Do you know Him like this?

- b. Make known His deeds! Creation – Salvation – Faithfulness from generation to generation!
- c. Sing to Him! This is songs to the God who is our all! Ps. makes it clear we are to sing NEW songs to Him.
- d. Talk of His wondrous works! These is making Him known to the gentiles (unbelievers)! This is a picture of declaring Him wherever you are!
- e. Rejoice in who He is!
- f. Seek the Lord and His strength! We are to let others know of our journey to know Him in all that He is!
- g. Remember His marvelous works! Meditate on works, His wonders, His judgments, and His wisdom!

The Psalmist then reminds us who He is and who we are!

- a. His servants - Called
- b. His children – Called into His family
- c. His Chosen ones! – Called into His family for His glory!

God is sooo glorious that He will be declared in the world! He desires us to get to be a part of that chorus of voices that get to sing His praise!

Let's not miss our time to Rejoice always in the Lord – To Praise His name – To declare His works, His wonders, and His wisdom to a world that needs Him today!

For us – Thanksgiving Day is every day in Jesus!
